Paula Amato, MD, MCR, is a reproductive endocrinologist and Associate Professor of Obstetrics & Gynecology at Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU). She obtained her medical degree at the University of Toronto where she also completed a residency in Obstetrics & Gynecology.

Subsequently, she completed a fellowship in Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility at the University of California, San Diego under Dr. Samuel Yen, followed by an AAOGF Fellowship.

Dr. Amato began her career as an Assistant Adjunct Professor in the Department of Ob/Gyn at the University of California, San Diego School of

Medicine. After which, she accepted a position as Assistant Professor of Ob/Gyn at the Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, Texas, ultimately relocating to join the medical and academic staff at OHSU.

Her expertise in translational research focuses on the practical aspects of state-of-the-art investigation. She also specializes in treating patients with infertility, menopausal issues, and reproductive endocrine disorders such as polycystic ovary syndrome and endometriosis.
