Mark P. Leondires, MD, received his undergraduate degree at Colby College in Waterville, Maine, followed by a medical degree from the Robert Larner, MD College of Medicine at the University of Vermont.

Dr. Leondires completed his residency in Obstetrics

and Gynecology at Maine Medical Center in Portland, which was followed by a fellowship in Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility at the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, Maryland.

After his training, Dr. Leondires accepted a position as the Director of Assisted Reproductive Technologies at the Combined Federal Program for Reproductive Endocrinology. Under his direction, the ART Program was one of the most successful in the Washington, DC area and in the top tenth percentile nationally.

During this time, he also served as an Assistant Professor at the Uniformed Services University of Health Sciences and on the clinical faculty for the Combined Fellowship in Reproductive Endocrinology.

Currently, Dr. Leondires is the Founder, Medical Director and Partner in reproductive endocrinology at Illume Fertility and Gay Parents To Be (GPTB). He is board-certified in both Obstetrics and Gynecology and Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility, and affiliated with several hospitals in the area, including Stamford Hospital and Danbury Hospital.

He is Past President of the ASRM LGBTQ Special Interest Group and a member of ASRM's Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Task Force, as well as a member of Resolve's Physician Council. Dr. Leondires has been selected as a Castle Connolly "Top Doctor" in CT & NY for consecutive years for nearly a decade.
