Managing Complex Cases



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ART nurses and care providers are often faced with challenging situations. This presentation will examine complex cases of pregnancy loss, bleeding, pregnancy of unknown location (PUL),

and ectopic pregnancy. Pregnancy loss is so disheartening for fertility patients and nurses play a key role in providing support. Talking points and understanding risks of early pregnancy such as bleeding, subchorionic hematomas, PUL, and ectopic pregnancy will be reviewed. The goal of this presentation is to aid ART nurses and care providers with critical thinking tools to properly triage calls and determine those which require urgent attention for safe patient care management.
